


PRESCRIBING GUIDANCE FOR SYMPTOM MANAGEMENT IN THE LAST HOURS OR DAYS OF LIFE





| MEDICATION | PRN DOSE | CSCI DOSE | MAX DOSE | ALERT |
|------------------------------|-------------------------------|-------------------------|--|---|
| Haloperidol | 0.5 – 1mg subcut Q1H PRN | 1-2.5mg subcut/24 hours | 5mg subcut/24 hours | Contraindicated in Parkinson's Disease |
| Metoclopramide | 10mg subcut Q4H PRN | 30 mg subcut/24 hours | 80mg subcut/24 hours | Do NOT use if abdominal colic present. Do not use concurrently with Buscopan. |
| Cyclizine | 25-50mg subcut Q8H PRN | 75mg subcut/24 hours | 150mg subcut/24 hours | Do not use concurrently with Metoclopramide. Dilute with WFI only. |
| Levomepromazine (Nozinan) | 3.125 – 6.25mg subcut Q2H PRN | 6.25mg subcut/24 hours | 25mg subcut/24 hours (Titrate dose up cautiously) | 'Broad spectrum' and is more sedating than others. |
